Nancy Kriseman

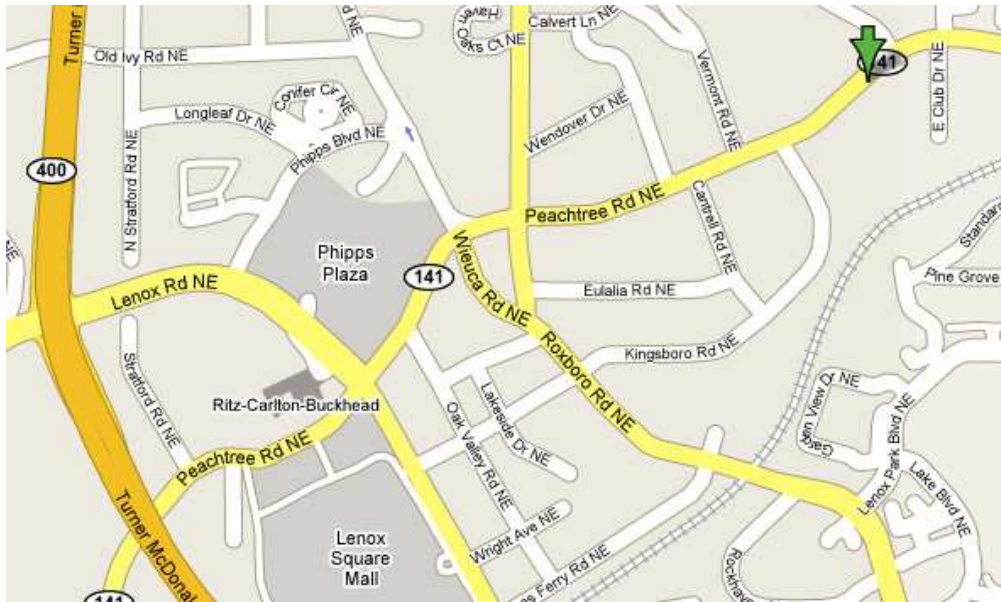

Directions from I 85 going North

- I 85 North
- To GA 400 N
- Take Lenox Rd./Peachtree Exit
- Follow the Peachtree Rd. Lane (Toward Phipps Plaza-Landmark)
- Turn Left at Light onto Peachtree Rd.
- Travel approx. 2 1/2 miles thru 2nd light (Landmark: BP Gas Station on Right)
- After passing BP Gas Station
- Travel 1/2 mile on the Left to Canterbury Court

Directions from I 85 going South

- Take GA400/Cheshire Bridge/Lenox Exit (88)
- Turn right onto Lenox Road
- Take Lenox Road to Peachtree (about 2 miles)
- Make a right on Peachtree Road
- Travel approx. 2 1/2 miles thru 2nd light (Landmark: BP Gas Station on Right)
- After passing BP Gas Station
